

Watermark Account Creation

Students are required to create a Watermark account (\$139 plus tax) either **before or during the first week of the admission semester classes.**

Directions:

- Log into Watermark at <https://sll.watermarkinsights.com>
- Log in using your NKU email. Make sure to include the “mymail” part of your email address or it will not work.
- Click “Forgot Password” to get a link to set password.
- Once you have created your password and attained access, you will be prompted to use a credit card to purchase Student Learning and Licensure for \$139 plus tax.
- You will have editable access to your Watermark account for seven (7) years.

What is Watermark?

Watermark replaces the Foliotek program NKU students used prior to Fall 2024.

Watermark is the new online e-portfolio program for all NKU College of Education teacher preparation programs. Electronic portfolios are crucial for the college’s state and national accreditation process because this is where we collect data to ensure candidates are meeting the required standards. This is important for you because it ensures you are getting your degree from an accredited institution. As a result, you will be required to purchase a Watermark account as part of your teacher preparation program. Disposition evaluations and other key assessments will be added to Watermark as you progress throughout your program.

You will need to purchase your account in order to complete your admissions paperwork.

The cost for your Watermark account is \$139 dollars (plus tax), and you will have access to an editable version of it for seven years. In addition to providing data and documentation that you have met the required standards, you will be able to create a sharable e-portfolio that you can share with future employers. Please follow the steps above to sign up and register for your Watermark account.
